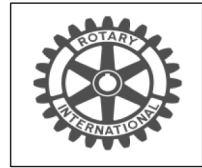

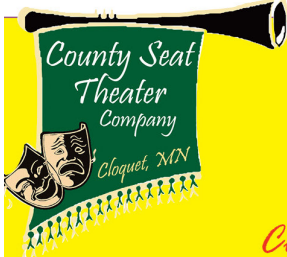

Sue Rauschenfels

In the *gallery*

Sue Rauschenfels grew up in a small town in Northern Minnesota in the 1960s. It was a time of carefree exploration with her six sisters in a neighborhood swarming with playmates. They made up their own play and rules and worked things out without parents in the mix. Through her sisterhood and strong neighborhood ties, Sue learned life-long lessons on working with others and on developing lasting relationships. Spending a lot of time outdoors, Sue developed her love of nature while enjoying quiet time outside for thinking and for recharging.

Sisterhood – a body of work Sue created was on view at the Duluth Art Institute Summer 2019. She continues to add paintings to her Sisterhood series and shares her statement and vision of the work:

“Women have always displayed the spirit of “connecting” to nurture and care for our families, friendships, communities and environment. We recognize we need to lift each other up, support and embrace our individual strengths in order to create a unified force for healthy social, political, and environmental change. We do this respectfully by inviting communication and collaboration as we share our ideas for healthy change across cultures. Our voices are being heard, and we’re only getting started.”

Sue began painting fulltime in 2009 after retiring from UMD. She has taken art classes and workshops locally, nationally, and internationally and is grateful to study and to connect with creative artistic mentors for inspiration and for support.

Sue’s love of nature, color, people and whimsy are often captured in her work. She enjoys telling a story in her work which is often as she sees things or dreams of how things should be rather than the realistic narrative. Sue is currently exploring abstract art and enjoying the challenge and excitement of learning to stretch and express her art voice.

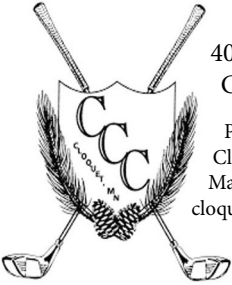

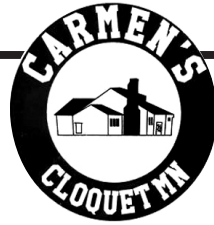
