COVID-19 Safety at the Encore

The County Seat Theater continues to put the health and safety of our patrons, volunteers, artists and staff first. CST staff, performers and volunteers are required to be vaccinated or required to submit a weekly Covid test. We will require masking in the theater only if Carlton County 7-day average is 25 cases or more. At that time Masks are REQUIRED FOR ALL in the theater common areas including lobby and gallery areas, if you are fully vaccinated they can be removed after you have been seated for the performance. Masks are available at the theater and hand sanitizer is available throughout the theater. If a patron is exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms or has possibly been exposed to someone who has we ask them to please stay home. Your tickets will be exchanged or refunded to you. At this time we have returned all of our seating and there is NO social distancing within the house. Policies can change daily.
